



**Old Aurora Colony Museum
37th Annual Quilt Show
Quilt Entry Guidelines
October 16-25, 2009**

We are making plans at the Old Aurora Colony Museum for our 37th Annual Quilt Show. Please fill out the Quilt Entry Form if you have a quilt that you would like to display. Quilts may be antique, vintage, contemporary or relate to this year's quilt show theme, "A Community of Quilts". Please complete one form for each quilt submitted.

Quilt Entry Form's with good quality color photo must be COMPLETED and received no later than September 11, 2009.

QUILT LABELS: All quilts must have an ownership label sewn or securely pinned on the back with the owner's name, address, telephone # and the size: ___" (top) x ___" (side).

QUILT SLEEVES: We use 1.5-inch wooden dowels to hang quilts, requiring quilts to have a 4" sleeve either sewn or pinned to the back. Directions for making and positioning sleeves are available at the museum.

QUILT CHECK-IN: All quilts **must** arrive at the Aurora Colony Museum, (Corner of 2nd & Liberty Streets, Aurora) **Monday, September 28th, 2009 between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm.**

If this time is inconvenient, please call the museum at 503-678-5754 to make other arrangements. Quilts may also be shipped to the Aurora Colony Museum. Call the museum for shipping instructions. You will be given a receipt at the museum when you bring your quilts. **DON'T LOSE IT!** You must have this receipt in order to pick up your quilts.

QUILT PICK-UP: All quilts should be picked-up at the Aurora Colony Museum, (Corner of 2nd & Liberty Streets, Aurora) **Wednesday, October 28, 2009 between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm.** If this time is inconvenient, please call the museum at 503-678-5754 to make other arrangements.

REMEMBER: YOU MUST BRING YOUR QUILT RECEIPT (given when quilts are delivered) **TO CLAIM YOUR QUILTS.**

Insurance coverage for entries is the sole responsibility of the entrants.

The Aurora Colony Museum reserves the right to decide how the quilts will be displayed. Not all quilts can be hung, they may be folded, draped or displayed with props. We also reserve the right to limit the number of quilts shown per person.

QUILT ENTRY FORM

This form must be COMPLETE and received no later than September 11, 2009

Each quilts holds a story unto itself. The information you provide about your quilt, it's maker, and other details will help us share the rich history of quilting. As a history museum we are as interested in the story behind the quilt as we are in the pattern and technique used in it's making. Information provided will enhance the catalog and the experience of the show.
