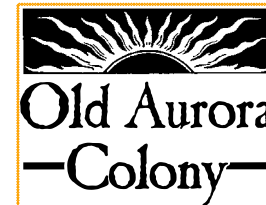

Twenty-fourth Annual Block Contest

The Old Aurora Colony Museum's quilt show began 45 years ago recognizing the tradition of quilting as a fine craft in the Aurora Colony. Today the museum collection numbers about 200 quilts. Twenty-three years ago the block contest began as a way for today's quilters to use their creativity and craft as well as creating a "raffle quilt" whose proceeds go to quilt preservation and research.

The challenge this year is to create a block using a "star" pattern and the colors black and red along with the white "star" fabric provided.

Entries are limited to two blocks per quilter.

Guidelines

- Unfinished blocks should measure *12 ½" x 12 ½" to finish as a 12" square.*
- *Please measure carefully.*
- Blocks should be made using a star design of your choice and should include the fabric provided. You may pick up the fabric at the museum or ask to have it sent to you in the mail.
- Blocks should **NOT** be set on point
- Blocks may be pieced or appliquéd. (if appliquéd, no fusing or gluing should be used and base fabric should be cut away)
- Blocks should be made of *pre-washed 100% cotton fabrics.*

The blocks will be judged first on size, then workmanship and overall appearance. Prizes will be awarded to twenty blocks, which will be used to make up the 2018 raffle quilt. All blocks entered will be used to make quilted items to be sold by ACHS. The proceeds from those sales will benefit the Aurora Colony Historical Society and its programs.

To enter: Please attach your name, address, and phone number to the back. All blocks will be displayed during the quilt show. Blocks should arrive at the museum no later than Friday, Oct. 20, 2017. Judging will be held after 4:00 p.m. that day. The twenty winners will be displayed Saturday, Oct. 21, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. at the Old Aurora Colony Museum.

Old Aurora Colony Museum 45th Annual Quilt Show Quilt Entry Guidelines October 13 - 22, 2017

We are making plans at the Old Aurora Colony Museum for our 45th Annual Quilt Show. Please fill out the Quilt Entry Form if you have a quilt that you would like to display. Quilts may be antique, vintage, contemporary or relate to this year's quilt show theme, "**Crazy About Aurora**" featuring Crazy Quilts. Please complete one form for each quilt submitted.

Quilt Entry Form's with good quality color photo must be COMPLETED and received no later than September 8, 2017.

QUILT LABELS: All quilts must have an ownership label sewn or securely pinned on the back with the owner's name, address, telephone # and the size: ____" (top) x ____" (side).

QUILT SLEEVES: We use 1.5-inch wooden dowels to hang quilts, requiring quilts to have a 4" sleeve either sewn or pinned to the back. Directions for making and positioning sleeves are available at the museum.

QUILT CHECK-IN: All quilts **must** arrive at the Aurora Colony Museum, (15018 2nd Street NE, Aurora, OR 97002) **Monday, September 25, 2017 between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm.**

If this time is inconvenient, please call the museum at 503-678-5754 to make other arrangements. Quilts may also be shipped to the Aurora Colony Museum. Call the museum for shipping instructions. You will be given a receipt at the museum when you bring your quilts. **DON'T LOSE IT!** You must have this receipt in order to pick up your quilts.

QUILT PICK-UP: All quilts should be picked-up at the Aurora Colony Museum, (15018 2nd Street NE, Aurora, OR 97002) **Wednesday, October 25, 2017 between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm.** If this time is inconvenient, please call the museum at 503-678-5754 to make other arrangements.

REMEMBER: YOU MUST BRING YOUR *QUILT RECEIPT* (given when quilts are delivered) **TO CLAIM YOUR QUILTS.**

Insurance coverage for entries is the sole responsibility of the entrants.

The Aurora Colony Museum reserves the right to decide how the quilts will be displayed. Not all quilts can be hung, they may be folded, draped or displayed with props. We also reserve the right to limit the number of quilts shown per person.
