

Sewing the Seeds of Next Year's Raffle Quilt

Let your creativity loose with your block design. Twenty winning squares will be pieced and hand quilted by the Old Aurora Colony Hand Quilters, then raffled as a fundraiser for the museum during the 2023 Old Aurora Colony Museum Quilt Show. Winners receive a bag of quilting-related goodies!

How to Participate_____

- Your block must follow the theme, "Aurora's Flower Garden".
- Incorporate some of the museum-provided fabric into your design.
- Use the provided fabric with quilting fabrics of your choice (novelty prints OK) as long as they are pre-washed 100% cotton. If you use white in the background, use true white or white-on-white, not cream or ivory.
- Size: 12½″ x 12½″ to finish as a 12″ x 12″ block. Do not set blocks on point.
- Block may be pieced and/or appliquéd. Appliqué must be trimmed on back.
- Please, no fusing or gluing of fabrics, and do not embellish with buttons, ribbons, lace, or doilies as they are too difficult to hand quilt.
- Blocks must be received by noon, Sunday, October 23rd for judging.
