Quilt Intake

Quilts may be brought to the Old Aurora Colony Museum between the hours of 11AM and 4PM, September 21st, 23rd, 28th, or 30th. Please contact the museum at 503-678-5754 or info@auroracolony.org for alternate arrangements.

Quilt Pick up

Submissions will be available for pick up Wednesday, October 26th – Friday, October 28th between the hours of 11AM and 4PM or by appointment. Your receipt / claim ticket will be required for pick up.

Submissions participating in the extended display will be available for pick up Thursday, January 5th – Saturday, January 7th, 2023 or by appointment.

Per Oregon State Law, ORS.358.420, if your item has not been retrieved by you, the owner, 7 years after the date that the item was left in the care of ACHS, this item will legally become a permanent gift, on the owner's behalf, to the Aurora Colony Historical Society.

Quilt Submissions

All submissions must include:

- Completed Entry Form signed by the owner
- Color photograph
- Quilter's statement (150 words or less)
- Quilt Sleeve: All quilts must have a sleeve attached to the back top of the quilt for display purposes. Please visit
 the Fab @ Fifty! website (www.auroracolony.org/events/fabatfifty) for instructions. The museum has a limited
 number of sleeves available for loan. Exceptions may be made for non-traditional quilts that do not require
 hanging for display or historically significant quilts. Please contact the museum to determine whether your
 submission qualifies.

Display Criteria

- All quilts must be show ready (clean, undamaged, and free of strong odors). Exceptions may be made for historical quilts.
- Due to hanging capacity, the Old Aurora Colony Museum will make every effort to display all submissions. However, the museum does not guarantee that all quilts submitted will be displayed and reserves the right to decline submissions.
- No more than 2 quilts per owner may be submitted for display.

Quilt Categories

- Show Theme: Quilts from, or inspired by, the 1970s to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the first Old Aurora Colony quilt show in 1972.
- Quilts celebrating a milestone.
- Your favorite quilt / open category.
- NEW: Repurposed quilts. This can be anything made from a quilt. This could be a bag, clothing, toy, etc. Let's see your creativity!

Two prizes will be awarded according to votes of attendees:

- People's Choice
