
CUTTING

Measure circumference of your rolled textile. Add 1" for seam allowance and 6" for a loose fitting sleeve.

Circumference plus 7" = width of piece you will need (A).

Measure width at widest point of your textile. Add 14" (2" for hems & 12" for length to tie sleeve closed).

Widest point plus 14" = length of piece you will need (C).



SEWING

SLEEVES (Tubular & Flat Styles)

- 1. Turn under 1/4" on shorter edges (A & B) and press
- 2. Turn again 3/4" on shorter edges (A & B) and machine hem.
- Sew edges C & D together with WRONG SIDES facing together and using 3/4"-1" seam allowance.
- 4. Press seam allowance open,
- 5. Turn the sleeve right side out.

(You may opt to skip steps #3 through #5 and keep your sleeve an open flat style with four hemmed sides. Sides C & D should be hemmed as in steps #1 & #2.)
